Last Fortnight Reminder	1. Play new games 2. Manners during eating time
Next Fortnight	Week 9 : Seeking help from school leaders - School leaders will be rewarding students who seek their help in the playground. Week 10: Students waiting quietly in line - School leaders will be rewarding students who wait quietly in line during lunch, recess and pick up .
Outline	Students earn a school behaviour reward card if they model being a respectful, resilient and safe learner. Each week the school leaders introduce a new expected behaviour during their peer support lesson. Once a combined tally of 100 reward cards has been achieved the school leaders will decide on a whole school reward.
Resilience Reminder	Resilience Reminder – If you are feeling angry in the playground please remember to 'STEP BACK' and then 'BOUNCE BACK. Remind yourself to step back and take a breath, think about the situation, walk away to a quiet spot, seek assistance from a school leader and then bounce back in a positive manner.

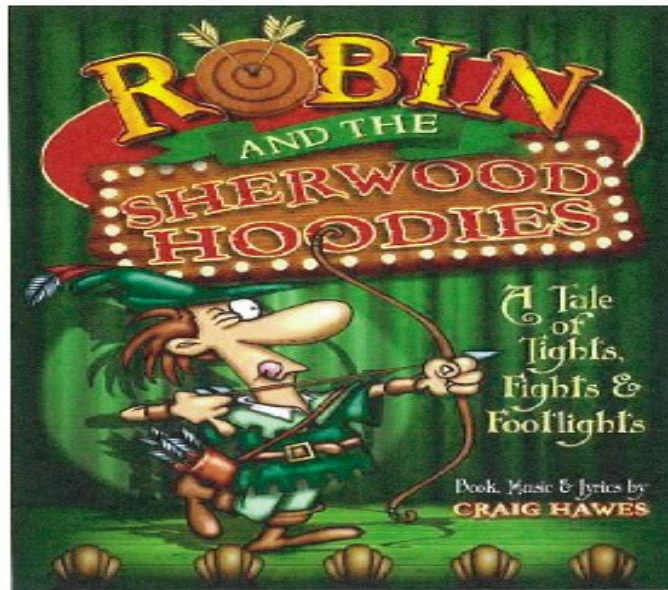

Burradoo Playgroup has been a valued part of the Southern Highlands community for over 43 years, beginning in a member's own house and continuing today. Our playgroup meets Tuesday (open during the school holidays) [from 9:30-11:30am](#) at the Berrima Pony Club rooms on the corner of Osborne and Moss Vale Rds, Burradoo. Children attending range from newborns to five year olds. The playgroup aims to be a place for parents, guardians and grandparents to come to enjoy time with their children, help the children to socialise with children of their age group, gain support and encouragement from other adults while building relationships together. Mornings at playgroup include free play in the secure indoor and outdoor area with a variety of toys to suit different age groups. There is often a craft or music or story time activity run in structured playtime. For morning tea a mixture of seasonal fruits are served for the children and a light morning tea with coffee and tea for the adults. New families are always welcome with free membership for families with a baby under 12 months old offered by playgroup NSW. Our weekly cost is either \$3.50 per session per child or \$30 per family per term, which goes towards rent, consumables, craft supplies and the purchase of toys. Come and play in the sun and sand(pit) with us.
